PATIENT INFORMATION ABOUT MIC AND YOUR MRI

How does magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) work?

MRI currently is the most advanced method for imaging internal parts of your body. It uses a large magnet, radio waves, and a computer to create incredibly detailed pictures of your body.

The test is fairly simple. During the test, patients are asked to lie still within the magnet for about 20 to 40 minutes. You will hear a mechanical knocking sound. Magnetic scanners do not use ionizing radiation.

What about insurance coverage?


Health insurance covers the cost of most MRI examinations. Call your individual health insurance provider directly to inquire about coverage and any preauthorization requirements.

What should you bring to your appointment?

Please report approximately 15 minutes prior to the appointment time. This referral form should be presented to our office reception staff.
Please bring any x-rays or CAT scan films with you. You should also bring your insurance information

For those exams that allow it, MIC is equipped with stereo head phones, so you may want to bring your favorite music to listen to during the scan.

Directions to MIC

From 81 North or South

- Take Exit 19 (Route 581 East) to Exit 3 (Carlisle Pike)
- Follow approximately 2.1 miles
- Stay in left lane, turn left at light onto Carlisle Pike
- Again, stay in left lane (approximately .3 miles), turn right at first light onto Sporting Hill Road
- Follow Sporting Hill Road .8 miles, turn left onto Trindle Road
- MIC will be .7 miles on your left

From 83 North or South

- Take Exit 20 (Route 581 West/Camp Hill

 exit will be off to the left)
- Follow 581 West to Exit 4 (Route 641 Mechanicsburg)
- Stay to the right on ramp, turn right onto 641 West
- Follow 641 West (Trindle Road)
- MIC will be .4 miles on your right

From Carlisle and South via Route 11

- Follow 11 North to Carlisle Pike
- Turn right off Carlisle Pike onto St. John's Church Road
- Proceed to traffic light at Trindle Road and turn right
- MIC will be on your right

From Route 15, heading north or south

- Take Route 15 to Camp Hill Borough
- Turn onto Trindle Road (Route 641 West)
- MIC will be 1.4 miles on your right
